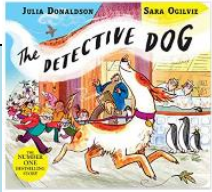


English: *We are readers and authors:*

Our daily phonics sessions will be helping us to read with increasing fluency. It will also help us with our spelling. In our writing we will be learning to write in sentences using capital letters, full stops and spaces between words. We will begin to ask some questions and to use question marks. We will learn to tell the story of *The Detective Dog* by Julia Donaldson with actions and rhymes, make changes and make the story our own. We will write an information text about *Guide Dogs for the Blind*.



History *We are historians:*

We will find out about the life of Louis Braille and understand why he is a significant person. We will be able to answer the question, "Why do we remember Louis Braille?" by giving examples from the past and present.



PSHRE: *We are citizens:*

We will learn about ourselves and our feelings. We will seek out information about rules, balance and making good choices at home and at school. We will understand our feelings and how they make us behave. We will learn how feelings and bodies can be hurt and how to be good friends.



Science: *We are scientists:*

We will learn to identify and name the parts of our bodies. We will perform simple tests to find out about the five senses. We will learn to observe carefully and record our observations, using these to ask and answer questions.

We are musicians:
We will explore pulse, rhythm and pitch. We will listen to a range of music and will learn to perform some songs by singing and playing. We will understand how music brings people together.



Art *We are artists:*

We will be able to draw pictures of animals, by learning how to use pencils, crayons, pastels and chalks successfully. We will explore the different lines and textures we can make with the media and make choices for our illustrations. We will look at the artists *Emily Gravett* and *Edgar Degas* to inspire us.

Maths: *We are mathematicians:*

We will ...

- Count and order numbers to 10 and beyond.
- Form digits and numbers clearly and find different ways to record our ideas.
- Find and make one more and one less than a number or set of objects.
- Begin to add and subtract with objects and make our own number-lines.

We will be able to talk about our learning with others and show our understanding using objects and pictures.



Computing: *We are programmers:*

We will learn to login and use Purple Mash on iPads. We will understand how to access different tools and to save our work. We will learn how to search for activities within Purplemash that we are interested in and may want to try at home. We will find out more about keeping ourselves safe online and share our new knowledge with family.



Physical Education: *We are athletes:*

We will be improving our coordination and accuracy when rolling, throwing and catching balls. We will learn how to be part of a team and to use our skills to play Kwik Cricket. We will understand why exercise is good for our health and what our bodies feel like before, during and after exercise.
